

Scholarship Competitions 2023

Saturday 16 to Sunday 17th of September

The scholarship competition is a fantastic opportunity for students and teachers alike. It fosters growth, encourages healthy competition, and provides valuable feedback. Held in September, it offers focused preparation between exams and school assessments. With an emphasis on technique, interpretation, and stage presentation, it's a rewarding learning experience. Plus, there are cash prizes and even an ice-cream for participants.

Entry eligibility: Entry is open to all NCMA enrolled students who are under the guidance of an NCMA accredited teacher. To enrol at NCMA for the year, the fee is \$30. You can complete the process online <u>click here</u> or by visiting the NCMA office at 48 Nile St.

Entry date: Entries open on Friday 4th August and close on Friday 9th September.

Entry Fees: First entry - \$10 | Each additional entry - \$5 | Ensembles - \$5 per person

Adjudicators: Elgee Leung and Josie Lau

Classes: With the exception of composition, all classes will be categorised by skill level. **Beginner** = up to grade 2 | Intermediate = grades 3-5 | Advanced = grades 6-7 | Expert = grade 8 and above. Please note:

- For music that is not from an established exam syllabus, please refer to the office and we will help ensure that you are entered into the correct class.
- Each entrant is allowed to participate in a maximum of two skill level classes within a category.
- In Group/ Ensemble classes, the skill level will be determined by the complexity of the most difficult part.
- Entrants must perform a different piece of music for each class in which they participate. (Please note the Instrumental Ensemble and the Piano Accompaniment are the only exception.)
- Composition: The classes are divided into two age bands for marking purposes. The first includes Primary & Intermediate age students, while the second band comprises Junior & Secondary students.

Music and scores: It is mandatory for the adjudicator to receive a copy of the music for EACH entry. Please ensure that you submit the music digitally or provide a physical copy for photocopying at the office when submitting your entry.

Marking: All performances and compositions will be marked out of 60.

- Instrumental: This will be broken down into 3 sub-headings, each worth 20 marks Accuracy | Interpretation | Performance.
- **Composition**: Marked out of 60, broken down into 3 sub-headings, each worth 20 marks Communication of Intent | Technical Execution | Performance Presentation.
- Honours = 54/60 marks | Distinction = 48/60 marks | Merit = 42/60 marks | Pass = 36/60 marks
